Construction update

June 2, 2010

Recent activities

- Continued excavating, backfilling and recovering oil in the Northwest Developed Zone (NWDZ).
- Continued excavating at the east end of the hydraulic control and containment (HCC) system. Railroad Avenue is temporarily reduced to one lane in this area; please look for trucks and pay attention to flaggers.
- Modified the underground bypass on Railroad Avenue and 6th Street.

What's happening next?

- Excavation and backfilling will continue in the NWDZ. **Railroad Avenue by the NWDZ will be temporarily closed through the end of this week.** Traffic will continue to access the school and west neighborhoods using West River Drive, which will remain a two-way street. Sixth Street will also remain closed during this work. Please pay attention to flaggers and posted street signs.
- Excavation and backfilling at the east end of the HCC system on Railroad Avenue is expected to be completed today. Crews are scheduled to start driving sheet pile on Thursday, June 3 and expect the work to take 2-4 days to complete. **Crews will be working in this area on Saturday, June 5, starting at 9AM.** After this work is complete, Railroad Avenue will be reopened to two-way traffic in this area.
- Crews are currently preparing the restaurant portion of the Cascadia for demolition, including disconnecting utilities and plumbing. Demolition is scheduled for later this week or early next. Excavation at the site is scheduled to begin the end of next week (week of 6/7).
- Preparations for work at the 5th Street Bridge will begin next week. Crews will begin restriping and installing additional signage on Highway 2 to prepare for the closure. The bridge is scheduled to close for 7 days beginning June 21. Crews will work long days and on weekends to accomplish the necessary work within the 7-day window. The cleanup team is working with WSDOT and will notify residents and the Town before the closure begins.
