Construction update

August 4, 2010

Recent activities

- Crews excavated the area south of the school building this week. Backfilling and re-grading is being completed and Railroad Avenue between West River Drive and 6th Street will be open today.
- Crews set the Community Center and the Town Maintenance building on their foundations last week.
- The Mackner house and cottage were lowered onto their foundations and restoration work will continue into next week.

What's happening next?

- Crews began prepping, clearing and grubbing the Former Maloney Creek West Wetland earlier this week and installed three small cofferdams. Crews will continue clearing and grubbing through this week and are scheduled to install a larger cofferdam next week.
- Work at the Former Maloney Creek East Wetland continues as crews finish clearing and grubbing the area. Excavation is scheduled to start tomorrow, August 5.
- Foundation work on the relocated buildings in the Northwest Developed Zone continues. Crews continue working on the Maloney's General Store and Ward foundations this week. The Wheatley foundation work will begin once those foundations are completed.
- Restoration work on the Cascadia continues, including framing walls and feeding electrical lines into the building.
- Final permits for in-river work near the 5th Street Bridge are currently under review by the National Marine Fisheries Service and Washington State Department of Fish and Wildlife.
