Construction update

Recent activities

- Many restoration items have been completed over the past couple weeks, including installing topsoil, seeding or laying sod, continuing interior building restoration in the Northwest Developed Zone (NWDZ) and at the Cascadia, and opening West River Road to traffic.

What's happening next?

- Take down remaining construction fencing next week. Crews will also stripe the tennis court and install the posts and net; the permanent tennis court surface will be completed in the spring.
- Install permanent street lights on 4th Street, 5th Street, 6th Street and Railroad Avenue next week. No power outages are expected to occur.
- As you've seen, crews are wrapping up all construction and restoration work for this year. Thanks again to everyone's patience, cooperation and help during another successful year of cleanup. Over 55,000 gallons of free product (oil) and 115,121 tons of contaminated soil were removed this year.
- Join us for the annual fall public meeting on Wednesday, November 17 to review plans for cleanup in 2011. It will be held at Maloney's General Store from 6:00 to 8:00 p.m. Stay tuned for more information.
- Since construction activities winding down, this will likely be the last regular construction update for the year. As always, there are many other ways to stay informed about the cleanup.
