Construction update

July 29, 2011

Recent activities

- Crews finished all curb, gutter and sidewalk construction on Railroad Avenue and adjacent streets east of 5th Street.
- Crews imported river rock in preparation for working in the river near the 5th Street Bridge.
- Crews continued restoration activities, including reinstalling the school yard fence near the west levee and relocating the Town kiosk to Depot Park.

What's happening next?

- In-river excavation near the 5th Street Bridge continues to be a priority. Crews are tentatively planning to install the cofferdam beginning next week, **pending river levels**. Traffic control measures will include closing access to East and West River Drives from 5th Street. Detour routes will be identified. The 5th Street Bridge will remain open to vehicles and pedestrians.
- Crews will continue restoration activities, including installing topsoil and sod at the west levee, irrigation and landscaping at Depot Park, and restoration behind sidewalks.
