## Construction update

February 12, 2009

### Recent activities

- **JOINT UTILITY TRENCH (JUT)**
  - Crews started work on the JUT this week. The JUT contains underground utilities that make it possible to eliminate overhead utility lines.
  - The JUT will primarily run underground along the south side of Railroad Avenue, but will cut across Railroad Avenue in several places to service buildings north of the street. Work started on the east end of Railroad Avenue this week and will continue to progress to the west.
- Work on the hydraulic control and containment system (HCC) continues. The HCC building is operational and crews will continue to work on installing the remaining recovery wells.

### What's happening next?

- **JOINT UTILITY TRENCH (JUT)**
  - Crews will continue work on the JUT for approximately 3 weeks.
  - The JUT will cross Railroad Avenue in several places. Crews will ensure access is maintained during trenching. When trenching and conduit installation is complete, crews will finish the trench using asphalt-treated base material.
  - Crews will install Verizon and PSE pedestals, street lighting bases, and other above-ground and flush permanent features that allow residents to utilize an underground utility system instead of overhead lines. This equipment will be placed on Town right-of-way adjacent to personal property in many places along Railroad Avenue and 4<sup>th</sup> Street.
  - The Town has coordinated with residents that will have underground utility equipment near their property line. Notification will be provided prior to work near personal property. Please contact Town Hall (360-677-2388) or Clint Stanovsky if you have questions about the placement of underground utility equipment (425-876-1649).
- Gravel will be delivered on Friday (2/13) to use in the HCC system vaults. Next week, granular activated carbon will be installed in the vaults. Residents should expect some truck traffic, but access to all roads and buildings will be maintained. Please drive with caution.
