Construction update

Recent activities

- Railroad Avenue pavement grinding from 6th Street past 2nd Street.
- Crews began work on the temporary railroad crossings. The 5th Street crossing remains open to traffic.
- Temporary water line bypass preparation.
- Crews continued preparing the railyard and BNSF property along Old Cascade Highway for soil handling and other staging activities.

What's happening next?

- Crews will continue to install a water line bypass along Railroad Avenue east of 3rd Street this week. This work will occur under the existing sidewalk along Railroad Avenue. Please be aware of any "No Parking" signs along Railroad Avenue.



- Construction of temporary railroad crossings will continue this week. **Notices will be posted in town and on the Skykomish Cleanup website when the date for the 5th Street crossing closure is identified.**
- Levee planting is scheduled for the end of this week.

Temporary railroad crossings are being constructed this week.
