## Construction update

June 12, 2008

### Recent activities

- Continued preparing the water line bypass along Railroad Avenue.
- Continued improving pedestrian walkways and signage, as well as traffic movement and stop sign enforcement in town. Please continue to call the Skykomish Call Line when you have questions or concerns (800-228-1849).
- Began sampling overburden material (e.g. soil), starting at the west end of Railroad Avenue and moving east. Contaminated material will be disposed of off-site.
- Removed trees located in or near areas of excavation or other construction work.
- Began asbestos abatement under the Depot.

### What's happening next?

- Sheet pile delivery begins on Friday, June 13. Piles will be delivered by trucks and rail, and will be stored on the rail yard.
- Sheet pile driving could begin as early as June 19. As previously described, this work will be noisy and will cause vibrations along Railroad Avenue. EnviroIssues will continue to work closely with residents who will be most directly affected by this work.
- Crews will continue preparing the Depot and McEvoy house for temporary relocation. Asbestos removal at the Depot should be complete by Monday, June 16. Building relocation is planned for the week of June 16.
- Crews will pave the soil handling facility on the rail yard and along Old Cascade Highway on Monday, June 16.
