

# Skykomish Cleanup



## Construction update

June 18, 2009

### Recent activities

- Installed construction fencing and prepared houses for temporary relocation.
- Completed asbestos abatement and began demolition of SkyRiver Inn buildings.
- Completed water bypass line testing and switched water service to the bypass system. This bypass system is underground and will be in use for about two years.
- Thanks for your patience as construction gets underway. Please take care and pay attention when walking near construction zones. Contractors have been asked to drive carefully through town and not park in residential and business parking areas.

### What's happening next?

- Finish demolishing the SkyRiver Inn this week and demolish the old post office building the week of June 22.
- Move the Martin house to its temporary storage location at the east end of Railroad Avenue, just west of the Depot. This will happen today or tomorrow. Flagger will be available to direct traffic if needed. The Sarno house will move to the same temporary location the week of June 22. These houses will be returned to their original locations this fall.
- Prepare for demolishing the Skykomish Hotel annex and continue preparations for temporarily relocating the Hotel. The annex will not be rebuilt.
- Relocate the Bishop house to its new permanent location on Old Cascade Highway. The new owner is expected to move the house the week of June 22. Traffic will be temporarily interrupted when the house moves across the railroad tracks; flaggers will assist with traffic control.
- Begin utility boring under the railroad tracks starting on Monday, June 22. Power interruptions are not expected. This work may affect traffic at the 5<sup>th</sup> Street and Railroad Avenue intersection and flaggers will assist with traffic control as needed.
- Prepare Maloney's General Store for relocation.
- Temporarily close and excavate a portion of 4<sup>th</sup> Street. This work is expected to begin the week of June 29. Residents and businesses will be able to access their properties via East River Road or Railroad Avenue until 4<sup>th</sup> Street reopens.
