Construction update

October 8, 2009

Recent activities

- Continued restoration work at Sarno and Martin properties, including concrete flatwork and siding repairs.
- Continued rail car load out. Load out of contaminated material is expected to continue through mid-November.
- Skykomish Hotel set on new foundation and restoration activities are underway.
- The oil recovery crews, MarVac, officially demobilized from the site after recovering approximately 40,000 gallons of oil in 2009.

What's happening next?

- Starting the week of October 12, crews will begin digging the joint utility trench (JUT) on the west side of 4th Street. The JUT will house underground utilities. Access on 4th Street will be maintained for vehicles and pedestrians.
- Backfilling is still underway and will be completed after crews backfill around the Skykomish Hotel and surrounding areas.
- Fifth Street is expected to reopen to traffic around the end of October, pending completion of joint utility trench work. Streets in town will be paved with asphalt-treated base (ATB) before winter.
- Continue restoration work at the Martin and Sarno properties, including completing concrete flatwork, exterior and interior restoration.
