

# Skykomish Cleanup



## Construction update

October 22, 2009

### Recent activities

- Continued restoration work at Sarno, Martin and Hotel properties.
- Completed the 4<sup>th</sup> Street joint utility trench (JUT) and started installing the 5<sup>th</sup> Street JUT and utility vaults. The 5<sup>th</sup> Street JUT will be complete tomorrow.
- Installed the outfall at the end of 4<sup>th</sup> Street.
- The Town of Skykomish continued installing community wastewater system septic tanks.

### What's happening next?

- Grade and prep 4<sup>th</sup> and 5<sup>th</sup> Street beginning on Monday, October 26. Asphalt treated base (ATB) streets and temporary sidewalks will be installed beginning on Monday, November 2. Parking and traffic will be affected; please avoid street parking if you see "no parking signs" so crews can pave the streets.
- Plats Plus, the Town's contractor, may begin installing septic tanks on 4<sup>th</sup> Street the week of October 26. Plats Plus will install tanks in the West River Road area next week and will continue asphalt patching on Old Cascade Highway.
- Install topsoil at the Martin and Sarno houses starting on Monday, October 26. Continue restoration work at the Martin, Sarno and Skykomish Hotel properties.
- Continue building the shed, stairs and landing at the Whistling Post. This work will be complete by the end of October.
- Temporary street lights will be installed this fall.
